

Walmart Donates \$50,000 to Dunbar Theater Restoration Project

Funds will support the revitalization efforts of the historic theater

What:

On Wednesday, July 15, Walmart will present a \$50,000 check to the Power Community Development Corporation (Power CDC) to support the Dunbar Theater restoration project during a celebratory check presentation. The donation is part of Walmart's commitment to investing and supporting the communities it serves, through local giving, volunteerism and programs that strengthen community cohesion.

The Power CDC is currently in the process of redeveloping the Dunbar Theater as a community-based visual and performing-arts center, which will provide surrounding neighborhoods with a facility to host meetings, receptions, youth activities and civic events.

Located in the historic McAdams neighborhood, the Dunbar Theater was built in 1941 and served as the only movie theater available to the African American community in Wichita until 1963. A recent revival of interest in the redevelopment of the area has brought new hope and the revitalization of the Dunbar Theater is a key component in the process of bringing new life into the renowned neighborhood.
